Dear People of Galilee,

I greet you as Rastafarians greet one another: "Peace and Love!"

At Bay Lake Camp this summer, we continued the tradition of having a Bible Study for the grown-ups on Saturday in the lodge. The topic I chose for our Bible Study was Rastafarian Christianity and Scripture in Reggae music. We listened to songs I had selected by Bob Marley and Lucky Dube, and also listened to the Reggae music that happened to be coming out of Bay Lake Camp's kitchen stereo while the camp staff member Ray-Ray was washing the breakfast dishes and preparing our lunch.

I have been interested in this Rastafarian interpretation of the Bible and the Pan-African movement since I was a teenager. At 17, I had the chance to make one of my dreams come true, which was to live in Africa. I went to South Africa by myself to meet my Zulu pen pal and to go to school near her in KwaZulu Natal. Around the same time, my cousin Odera had been living in Kenya to get to know family and to learn the Swahili language. Later the next summer, at a Nelson family reunion on grandma's farm in Grove City, Minnesota, my cousin Odera and I bonded over our love for Africa and hope to return there. Odera introduced me to the Reggae music of Peter Tosh, Burning Spear, Third World, and of course, Bob Marley. Rasta culture and spirituality view Africans as God's chosen people, and Africa as the "promised land". In the Bible Study my husband Tom Ososki helped us understand the Rastafarian connection to the late Emperor Haile Selassie, and the ancient Ethiopian Orthodox Church which still thrives today, and descends directly from a long line of kings that go back to King Solomon and Queen Sheba in the Bible.

Thank you for the opportunity I had to dig into this theme. There is much to share and much music to enjoy while exploring the lyrical roots in the verses of the Bible.

Sandy has spent most of her vacations camping. The farthest she has ever been from St. Paul is Las Vegas. Her favorite season is spring because it represents the beginning of new life with flowers and leaves bursting out. It is really a miracle every year.
